- Albumin constitutes 50-75% of blood proteins
- It is made in the liver
- It helps to maintain the pressure that holds water within the blood vessels

- It moves substances such as medications, lipids, bilirubin, hormones, minerals, and fat-soluble vitamins around your body as needed
