



## Tip Sheet for Entering Hepatitis B and Pneumococcal Vaccination Data in CROWWEB

The following CMS CROWNWeb guidance has been provided by the ESRD National Coordinating Center (NCC) as a reference. However, please contact Network staff at 919-463-4528 if a thorough review of your facility's vaccination data is required for reconciliation. ### Pneumococcal Vaccinations (PPV)

**Pneumococcal Vaccinated:** P13 and P23 year is not null and contains a valid date **OR** year is > = '2012'

[note: PPV is a 5 year vaccination. In 2017, any vaccinations prior to 2012 would be out of date]

**If the vaccination was administered OUTSIDE of the dialysis unit, there MUST be documentation in the Patient's Medical Record in order for the vaccination to be counted.** (*The documentation box in CROWNWeb must also be checked*)

**Pneumococcal Eligible:** Any patient NON vaccinated is eligible (P13 and P23 year is null or < '2012')

If there is no clinical or vaccination data entered, the patient will be considered eligible.

**Pneumococcal Exclusions:** If P13 or P23 'Reasons not documented' are in reason codes 1 or 2 (Medical, Medical other), i.e. patient declined the vaccination for medical reasons, patient will not be considered eligible.

### Hepatitis B Vaccination Eligibility Criteria

**HBV Vaccinated:** HBV Initial Shot 3 date > = the baseline start (9/1/2015) **OR** HBV Surface Antibodies >= 10.0 mIU/mL

**HBV Eligible:** Any patient NOT vaccinated is eligible (Patient did not receive all 3 vaccines in series, HBV Initial Shot 3 date < the baseline start date (9/1/2015), or and HBV Surface Antibodies < 10.0 mIU/mL)

**Exclusions to HBV Eligible:** Vaccination was not received due to a Medical reason **OR** The HBV Surface Antibodies field contained 'non-converter', 'non-responder', or 'non-reactive'.

## Instructions for Entering the HBV Surface Antibody Field in CROWNWeb

CROWNWeb allows for the entry of non-numeric values into the hepatitis B (HBV) Surface Antibody Field in CROWNWeb. In order to account for these scenarios, and apply this element to definitions of eligible and vaccinated, which require numeric values only, logic is implemented to **convert non-numeric values to numeric-only values**.
